RANGE RULES:

) **Hours** – Monday thru Saturday - 9a.m. to Dusk / Sun. – 10a.m. to Dusk

) When a Range Officer is on duty, he/she is in charge.

) ID cards must be presented upon request.

) Obey the Four Rules of Firearm Safety when on the Ranges.

) All firearms must be put up and unloaded while anyone is down range.

) Paper Targets Only

) Targets are to be attached so that they will not damage the frames.

) Make sure your target is straight in front of you.

) No fully automatic firearms at any time!

) No one under the influence of drugs or alcohol is to be on the range.

) No smoking at Black Powder Shoots.

) Clean up your targets, cardboard and any other mess before you leave.

(It's nice to leave the ranges better than you found it.)

) After unlocking Gate lock, do not leave the combination showing.

Flip tumblers.

) Unless a sanctioned event is taking place, close the gate behind you when you enter the grounds to avoid trespassers.

) If you are the last member leaving the club, be sure the gate is secured/locked when departing the grounds

) If you bring a guest, you are responsible that they obey all Range Rules.

) If you witness any violations, please report them along with a license plate number to any Club Officer.

) No 50 cal. BMG or modern rifle 50 cal. ammo may be used on our range.

) No steel jacketed, armor piercing, tracers or incendiary ammo will be allowed.

***Any member(s) or guests violating these rules are subject to range privileges and/or membership being revoked.***

## **The Salem Hunting Club Points System**

**Membership points may be earned by any of the following methods:**

- Attending the monthly membership meetings – ½ point each.
- Any work done for the club – 1 point per hour.
- Other points may be earned by various means that the membership approves (votes) at any regular meeting.

**Each member must earn ten (10) points per year *or* pay \$10.00 per unearned point at the end of the club's fiscal year.**

Members that are not required to earn the ten (10) points are as follows:  
Club Officers, Trustees, and Life Members.

**There are two (2) ways to qualify as a life member:**

- To be voted a life member by the club's membership.
- Your years of age + years membership = ninety (90) or more.

Any member unable to earn his/her points because of bad health or circumstances beyond their control will not be held accountable for the required points. The officers will review these cases and decide whether the circumstances are justified.

The Points Officer is responsible for recording points earned for all members.  
**It is the responsibility of each member to report to the Points Officer all points earned and how they were earned.**

**Points are to be earned by the end of the club's fiscal year.**

A pro-rated system is used for new members joining other than at the beginning of the fiscal year.

- 1 (one) point required per month left in the fiscal year.

***\* Any member failing to accumulate the required points or failing to pay the \$10.00 per unearned point in the year will lose his/her membership.***

*In addition to the Range Rules, the following items are things you should be aware of. If you have any questions, please contact a club officer.*

**Club House:** It's available to members for private functions as long as there are no scheduling conflicts with club business. Contact the club president to reserve it. Ranges on days of sanctioned shoots

Time is needed to set up prior to sanctioned shoots. Please consider this when planning a trip to the range. Consult the club calendar and plan accordingly.

**Rifle Range:**

Put out the orange flag when going down range. This designates a cold range. Rifles shall be unloaded and removed from the benches while people are down range. Don't leave the flag on the range when you're leaving for the day. Don't walk behind the 100 yd. backstop. Stay in front of it so you can be seen when down range.

Pistols - Use on the rifle range is permitted, especially if you want to shoot 25 yards and beyond. Use discretion when choosing to do this. If the pistol range is open, you may find it better to utilize that range primarily for pistol shooting at 25 yards.

You may not shoot from the grass with a pistol when people shooting from the bench are using the rifle range. Spring clamps should be used to place your cardboard on the horizontal rails. Staples may be used for attaching your target to the cardboard.

Be certain to place your target on the rails so that you won't be shooting the vertical posts and to minimize the chance of hitting the horizontal rails.

\* Should you break a rail, there are materials on hand to replace / repair the rail. Please do so.

**Pistol Range:**

No rifles of any kind may be used there.

High powered handguns that will damage the backstop should be shot at the rifle range.

**Trap Range:**

You may use your own thrower to practice. Be sure to shoot towards the tree line.
